**CALL TO ORDER** Mr. Myers called the Budget Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Gregg Township to order at 6:20 p.m.

**BUDGET REVIEW**

The proposed budget was discussed and reviewed. The increase in our health Insurance premium was discussed. **Mr. Bierly made a motion to keep the same insurance carrier and plan for another year. **OTHER BUSINESS**

**Gingrich Gap Road:** The Board received a letter from Norman Spackman, Centre County 911. There was a conflict with the road name of Gingrich Gap Road between Miles and Gregg Township. After reviewing the letter, **Mr. Bierly made a motion to keep the name of Gingrich Gap in Gregg Township and rename the Miles Township portion of this road. This will impact only one resident in Miles Township. Second by Mr. Stover. No further discussion. Vote in favor was unanimous. 3 – 0** Ms. Snyder will get back to Mr. Spackman at the County Office.

**Joint Meeting:** The joint meeting agenda was discussed and assignments were made for food and presentations. This meeting will be held on November 3, 2014.

**Advertising:** Mr. Stover made a motion to approve the expenditure to advertise the joint meeting and budget meeting notice. **Second by Mr. Bierly. No further discussion. Vote in favor was unanimous. 3 – 0**

Mr. Bierly made a motion to approve the expenditure to advertise the public notice that we will post weight limits on certain township roads. **Second by Mr. Stover. No further discussion. Vote in favor was unanimous. 3 – 0**

**Burn Ordinance:** Mr. Stover made a motion for the Planning Commission to review and update the burn ordinance. Review the definitions including the definition for outdoor wood burning stoves. Consider referencing the state regulations which covers this subject. **Second by Mr. Bierly. No further discussion. Vote in favor was unanimous. 3 – 0**
